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- You agree to make sure that you will leave the bunkers fully raked, how you would like to find them.
- Repair/replace your divot after every shot when hitting towards the green.
- You agree to ensure that during every practice session you have with you a pitch fork and that you repair your pitch mark plus any others you come across.
- So that management can check that only members are using the facility you are required to always have your SGGA membership card with you whenever you're practicing.
- Please make sure that you follow the 'Golf Etiquette' and Rules of Golf whilst on the SGGA practice area.
- If another player using the SGGA practice area is on the putting green, you agree to NOT hit onto the green until the green is completely clear.
- A maximum of 3 people practicing at any one time. If 3 people are already practicing you MUST wait your turn until a space becomes available
- Courtesy is given to those who are waiting to start the 1<sup>st</sup> hole, not someone wishing to continue after the 9<sup>th</sup> hole to play another round.
- The practice membership only permits the member to use the Short Game Golf Course and does NOT allow the use of the long hitting (teaching only) area.
- Short Game Golf Academy will contact you regularly with tuition tips/newsletters and lesson promotions and will not pass on your details to any other third party.
- This membership does not provide you with any insurance and we recommend that you take out your own golf insurance so that you are fully covered.
